<b>Pinot Noir - Les Volets (Pays de la Haute Vallée de l'Aude, France)</b> A serious Pinot Noir, sourced from the foothills of the Pyrenees.	£24

<b>Fleurie, Millisime, Cave de Fleurie (Burgundy, France) (V, Vg)</b> From the Beaujolais sub region using the Gamay grape, this wine is bursting with ripe fruit, yet soft, fresh with delicate & light tannins.	£37			
<b>Chianti Fontella DOCG (Tuscany, Central Italy) (V, Vg)</b> Aged for three years in large Slavonian oak barrels, a ruby red classic.	£24
